NOTE

Sri Sathya Sai Higher Secondary School is an unaided school, giving free education to all the children. It is affiliated to CBSE, New Delhi with affiliation no: 130015. It has been functioning since 1982.

The school will be following meticulously the RTE Act 2009 and is going to conduct the First Standard admissions for the year 2012-2013 through random method. As per the act, 25% of the seats filled by the categories shown by the act i.e.

1. Orphans, handicapped, HIV etc. 5%
2. Scheduled caste 10%
3. Scheduled Tribe 4%
4. Economically Weaker sections 6% (Below Rs.60,000 income)

The remaining 75% of the open seats are also filled by random method for the year 2012-2013. As per the guidelines issued by the MHRD letter no: F.No: 1-15/2010-EE-4 Department of School Education & Literacy dated 23-11-2010 under section 35(1) of RTE Act 2009.

In view the needs and objectives of Sri Sathya Sai Central Trust, the managing and funding body of the school following categorization is formulated for remaining 75% of open seats for the admission to 1st standard based on rational, reasonable and just policy keeping in view the employees serving in the school and sister organizations. This is formulated as per the guidelines issued under section 35(1) of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 regarding procedure for admission in schools under section 13(1) and section 12(1)(c) of the RTE Act dated 23-11-2010.

PREREQUISITE CONDITION FOR ADMISSION FOR CLASS I

1. Weight of 15kgs + Height of 100cms at the time of admission
2. Child should have received the following vaccination prior to admission.
 - a) 1 dose of BCG + 3 doses of DPT and OPV + 3 doses of Hepatitis B+1 dose of measles Vaccine during the first year of life.
 - b) Atleast one dose of MMR + Chicken Pox, 2 doses of Hepatitis A and DPT + OPV booster during second year of life.
 - c) 2 doses of Typhoid vaccine, 1 after 2nd birthday and the other just before admission to the school + 2nd booster of DPT and OPV before admission.
3. An immunization card duly signed by the family doctor or certifiable to prove the same from the doctor has to be produced at the time of admission.

The Parents need to provide the family doctors name, add and mobile number.

Most Important: Parents whose children suffer from diseases such as epilepsy, unstable asthma, conditions needing special kind of diet, chronic heart or kidney of lung diseases and bed wetting should refrain applying for admission.
